All applicants must lodge security with the Wellington Regional Chamber of Commerce. The security will be drawn upon to reimburse the Chamber in the event it incurs a claim for sales tax/duty or loss in connection with the issuance of your Carnet or its use. Security will be returned in full once the original Carnet has been returned and no claims are anticipated by the Chamber.

The amount of the security deposit is based on the total value of the goods and varies according to the countries visited. Refer to the Security Rate Chart to work out the amount of security you need to lodge - use the maximum rate that is applicable to your categories of goods and countries of destination. If you require assistance please feel free to contact the Wellington Chamber on 0508 CARNET (227 638).

You may lodge security in one of the following forms: Cash Indemnity or Bank Indemnity.

## **Notes:**

- The security rates are percentage figures and include a 10% penalty rate.
- The rate of security required for the following countries is 100% for all categories of goods: Algeria, Andorra, Bulgaria, People's Republic of China, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Gibraltar, Hungary, Iceland, Iran, Israel, Ivory Coast, Latvia, Lebanon, Lithuania, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Malta, Morocco, Romania, Russian Federation, Senegal, Slovenia, South Africa, Switzerland, Thailand, Tunisia, Ukraine.
- Chile has a rate of 29% for all items
